## **From Pastor Tom**

*Good morning! I'm glad you're here!*

*In our sermon today, we'll consider Articles 4 and 5 of the Statement of Faith of the Evangelical Free Church, the denomination to which Crossroads belongs. Those two articles are about the Person and the Work of Jesus Christ:*

***We believe that Jesus Christ is God incarnate, fully God and fully man, one Person in two natures. Jesus - Israel's promised Messiah -- was conceived through the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He lived a sinless life, was crucified under Pontius Pilate, arose bodily from the dead, ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father as our High Priest and Advocate.***

***We believe that Jesus Christ, as our representative and substitute, shed his blood on the cross as the perfect, all-sufficient sacrifice for our sins. His atoning death and victorious resurrection constitute the only ground for salvation.***

*Jesus is the most unique person who ever lived! He's alive today and present with us! Let's discover afresh why knowing and loving him is the best thing that can happen to us!*
