Good morning! I'm glad you're here!

In the Old Testament the people of God appear to have given three tithes -- a tithe which went to support the ministry at the Tabernacle or Temple (Numbers 18); a tithe that families used to celebrate the festivals in Jerusalem (Deuteronomy 14); and, every third year, a tithe that was set aside to help those in need (Deuteronomy 14).

At Crossroads, we currently have three funds a person can give to: the general ministry fund of the church; a "Blessing Fund" which we use to help with special needs that arise in people's lives; and a Building Fund to help purchase or build a future home. Thank you for your generous giving according to how the Lord has blessed you! Sacrifice and trust are qualities God is interested in developing within us!

Another kind of sacrifice we can offer today is what the Bible calls "a sacrifice of praise." "Through Jesus, then, let us *continually* offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name. And do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such sacrifices God is pleased" (Hebrews 13:15-16).
